Strengthening Stake and Ward Clerks*

- 1. When a stake presidency is reorganized, the stake clerk need not be released. The tenure of clerks should be of sufficient time for them to learn their duty and magnify their calling.
- 2. Before a new unit can be organized or when there is a leadership change, a faithful tithe payer of unquestionable integrity should be called to serve as clerk. He should be called in the same manner as counselors in the stake presidency or bishopric.
- 3. When a new ward clerk is called, the stake clerk should train him within 30 days. Stake clerks should also conduct training sessions for ward clerks and quorum and group secretaries in stake priesthood leadership meetings.
- 4. Stake presidents should assign clerks to follow up on all audit points within 30 days after the audit.
- 5. The bishop or bishopric member who receives the pink copy of the Baptism Record should give it to the ward clerk to prepare the Confirmation Record/Baptism and Confirmation Certificate for presentation following the individual's confirmation.
